\*The Academic Coaches move many of the Exploratory students to degree programs. This means the remaining students are often unsure of what they want to pursue, have not met GPA requirements for degree programs, or are unsure about continuing in school due to financial/family considerations. This uncertainty contributes to a slower rate of registration for the next semester. In response to these factors, our Academic Coaches are increasing their outreach to this student population.
